

Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue, Manchester

Acquisition of the Spanish and Portuguese Synagogue in the Cheetham Hill area of Manchester, designed by Edward Salomon, one of Manchester's most distinguished Victorian architects. Founded in 1873, it was the first Sephardi synagogue to be built outside London. For restoration and conversion to a museum of Jewish life.
