

## **Ashwellthorpe Lower Wood, Norfolk**

Acquisition of 37 hectares of ancient coppice and woodland. The woodland is recorded in the Domesday book and is now an SSSI (Site of Special Scientific Interest), having a continuous wooded history. Woodland type is oak, ash, and hornbeam woodland of national importance and with many usual ancient woodland features and excellent display ramsons (*allium ursinum*) and wood spurge (*euphorbia amygdaloides*).
