

Morgan's Hill, Wiltshire

Acquisition of Morgan's Hill, c 12.5ha, which is a SSSI and consists of gently sloping downland scarp, most of which is unimproved chalk downland, with a predominantly northerly aspect. The reserve is noted for its flora, in particular 11 orchid species. The nationally scarce round headed rampion (*Phyteuma orbiculare*) also occurs. It is also important for butterflies, in particular the Duke of Burgundy.
