Morgan's Hill, Wiltshire

Acquisition of Morgan's Hill, c 12.5ha, which is a SSSI and consists of gently sloping downland scarp, most of which is unimproved chalk downland, with a predominantly northerly aspect. The reserve is noted for it's flora, in particular 11 orchid species. The nationally scarce round headed rampion (phyteuma orbiculare) also occurs.
