

Navan Fort, Co Armagh

Acquisition of archaeological landscape surrounding Navan Fort, a commanding hilltop enclosure 2.5 kilometres to the west of Armagh City. It is the site of a legendary Emain Macha, the political and spiritual capital of the Kings of Ulster. It is also the earliest historically identified site in Ireland, recognised as Eamhonia in Ptolemy's 2nd century AD map.
